

GUIDELINE RULES FOR SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS
PANLAW.ORG



The following is a guideline for the submission to PANLAW of articles for inclusion on the website. Guidance for webinars will be the subject of similar guidance.

1. An article must be current and must also be directly related to COVID-19 or pandemic issue
2. All articles are subject to review and approval by the executive committee before publication; however liability for the article remains with the authors.
3. Articles which are written on non-Covid related subjects and which are merely tweaked to include a vague mention of COVID-19 a pandemic are unlikely to be approved for publication.
4. Only panel members can submit articles for publication.
5. Articles should be sent to enquiries@panlaw.org and should have a single word in the Subject line of "Articles"
